






Jack Tatum intercepts a pass in the 1974 Michigan Game

Chapter 4: The 2002 National Championship


The 2002 National Championship was Ohio State's first national championship in 34 years. The Buckeyes defeated the Miami Hurricanes 31-24 in double overtime.




